

What is Direct Testing?

At some point, we all have questions about our health. Direct Testing allows you the privacy to order your own routine laboratory tests. Once you receive your results electronically, you can print them, share them with your doctor or simply save them for a comparison for the next time you have labs completed.

What are the benefits of having this type of testing?

Direct Testing is for patients who want answers about their own health. The Medical Foundation does not submit paperwork to insurance companies; this is a direct patient-to-lab transaction and is completely confidential. We are the locally operated lab your doctor uses, so you never have to worry about accuracy or dependability.

Do I need to see my doctor?

You do not need a doctor's order to have labs performed with Direct Testing. However, if your results are abnormal, we encourage you to see your physician.

What forms of payment are accepted?

We accept cash, Mastercard, VISA and debit cards. We do not file insurance for Direct Testing.

How will I receive my results?

You will receive instructions on how to access your results online through our patient portal. If you don't have online access, you can pick up your results at any of our locations. If you request, we will also send test results to your physician.
